# From the Pastor's Desk Stewardship of Time Commitment

I understand the Bible to teach that God made time. It belongs to Him. My time is controlled by God (Ps. 31:15). It is a mark of spiritual maturity to value time as a precious commodity that is controlled in quantity by God while its quality depends greatly upon my right choices. The Bible challenges me to consider the purpose of time, redeeming the time for God's glory by fashioning my life after the wisdom of the Word of God and not an evil world (Eph. 5:15-16). This means that I must dedicate myself to proper time management by keeping Him in the center of my life (Col. 4:5). I must be devoted to Him so that my life will be lived to work out His purposes in honorable employment (Luke 10:41-42). My needed leisure time should recreate me to fulfill His intended purposes in my life. Since time belongs to God, I can never obediently leave Him out of my plans for time.

In this biblical sense, every day of my Christian life is the Lord's day, while Sunday is that special Lord's Day of resurrection celebration that the Scriptures ask me to give wholly to corporate worship and service through the local church (I Cor.16:2; Acts 20:7; Rev.1:10; Heb.10:25). I must have proper worship to make work what I live to do for God, not just what I do to live. This means that I must ...

#### \*RECIPE CORNER\* **CALIFORNIA-STYLE BARBECUE CHICKEN PIZZA**

3/4 lb. boneless skinless chicken breasts, cut into thin strips 1 green pepper, cut into strips 1/4 cup thin red onion slices 1 refrigerated ready-to-use baked pizza crust (12 inch) 1/3 cup BULL'S-EYE Original Barbecue Sauce 1 1/2 cups KRAFT Shredded Triple Cheddar Cheese with a Touch of PHILADELPHIA **HEAT** oven to 400 degrees F.



- 1. COOK and stir chicken and vegetables in large skillet sprayed with cooking spray on medium-high heat 4 to 5 minutes or until chicken is done.
- 2. SPREAD pizza crust with barbecue sauce; top with chicken mixture and cheese. Place crust directly on middle oven rack.
- 3. BAKE 15 to 18 minutes or until cheese is melted.
