RECIPE CORNER

CHOCOLATE BANANA PIE

- 1 (6 oz.) Graham Cracker Pie Crust
- 1 (3.9 oz.) box instant chocolate pudding mix.
- 1 3/4 cup of milk
- 1 small banana
- 8 oz. non dairy whipped topping

- *Mix together pudding mix and milk in a small bowl with a whisk for 2 minutes.
- *Fold in 1/2 cup whipped topping.
- *Pour half of pudding mixture into pie crust.
- *Place banana slices over pudding.
- *Pour remaining pudding over bananas.
- *Top with remaining whipped topping.
- *Refrigerate for 2 hours or until set.
