#### RECIPE CORNER

## CHICKEN BURRITO SKILLET

- 2 tablespoons Pure Wesson Canola Oil
- 1 pound of boneless skinless chicken breast, cut into bite size pieces
- 1/2 cup chopped yellow onion
- 2 tablespoons taco seasoning mix (from 1-25) Oz package
- 1 can (15 Oz. each) Rosarita Premium Whole Black Beans, drained and rinsed.
- 1 can (10 oz. each) Ro"Tel" Original Diced Tomatoes & Green Chilies, undrained.
- 1 cup water
- 1- 1/4 cups instant brown rice uncooked
- 1 cup shredded Cheddar and Monterey Jack cheese blend
- Chopped cilantro, optional
- 1.Heat oil in large skillet over medium heat. Add chicken and cook 3 minutes stirring occasionally. Add onion and taco seasoning, cook 2 minutes more. Stir in black beans, undrained tomatoes and water. Bring to a boil.
- 2. Stir in rice. Cover, reduce heat and simmer 7 to 10 minutes or until rice is tender. Stir in 1/2 cup of cheese. Sprinkle top with remaining cheese and cilantro if desired.
