Common Objections to God's Sovereignty

Sunday, October 3, First Street observed our Church Anniversary and Auxiliary Day. Rev. Perry Greenwade and Little River Baptist Church was our guest.

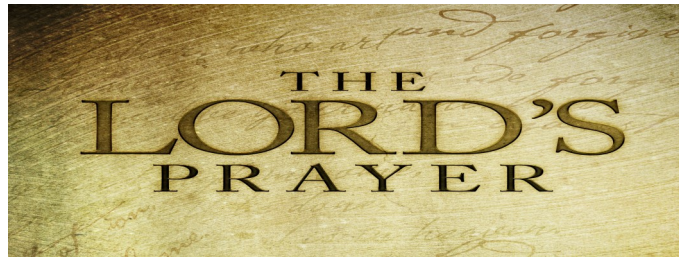
