### SHRIMP DIP

- 1 Package ( 8 ounces) cream cheese, softened
  - 1 can (10 3/4 ounces) Campbell's Condensed Cream of Shrimp Soup
  - 1/2 teaspoon Louisiana-style hot sauce
  - 1/4 cup finely chopped celery
  - 1 tablespoon finely chopped onion
- Stir cream cheese until smoothed. Stir in soup, hot sauce, celery and onion. Refrigerate at least 4 hours.
