RECIPE CORNER

OVEN GLAZED CHICKEN

4 chicken breast halves or 4
 chicken legs

1 can (11 1/8 oz.) Campbell's
 Italian Tomato Soup.

1 tbsp. water

1 tbsp. vinegar

1 tbsp. Worcestershire Sauce

1 tbsp. packed brown sugar.

Remove skin from chicken.

In 2 quart oblong baking
 dish, arrange chicken, Bake
 at 375 degrees for 30 min-
 utes.

Combine remaining ingredi-

ents: spoon over chicken.
 Bake 30 minutes or until
 chicken is no longer pink
 and juices run clear.
