#### STRAWBERRY PIE

(2 - 3 PIES)

(1 - 2) quarts of strawberries (thinly sliced)

1 can Eagle Brand milk or any brand sweetened condensed milk.

1 large tub cool whip or 2 small ones

2 - 3 graham cracker crust pie shells
