## RECIPE CORNER

### BREAKFAST ENCHILADAS

In a skillet over medium-high heat, brown 1lb bulk sausage, breaking it up with a spoon. Drain fat. Let cool slightly, then stir in 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese and 1 1/2 oz. bacon bits. Spoon mixture down the center of 8 flour tortillas. Roll up and place seam side down in a 13 x 9 inch baking dish coated with nonstick cooking spray. In a large bowl, beat together 6 eggs, 1 Tbsp. flour and 1/2 tsp salt. Mix in 2 cups half-and-half. Pour over the tortillas in pan. Cover the dish and place in the fridge overnight (or bake immediately). When ready to bake, sprinkle 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese and 1 1/2 oz. bacon bits over tortillas. Cover with foil and bake at 350 degrees for 35 minutes. Uncover dish and bake 10 minutes longer or until eggs are set and cheese is melted. Serves 6.
